## **September 13: 2 short films**

In 2013 a canvas was newly confirmed to have been painted by Vincent Van Gogh. Are there more of his hidden masterpieces waiting to be unearthed? 44 mins.

In 1911, Leonardo Di Vinci's Mona Lisa went missing from the Louvre for two years. Chief suspect was Pablo Picasso. 44 mins.

**September 27:** Anthony Hopkins gives a full-throttle performance as acclaimed artist Picasso in this movie told from the viewpoint of his longtime mistress and mother of his children Claude & Paloma. 2 hr. 5 mins.

**October 11:** This film features more than 60 works by American and European painters and sculptors who were featured in this groundbreaking show. This is about a new art brought to a new American audience. As Americans passed through the doors of an armory to see the new art, they passed through the doors of the Modern Era. 84 mins.

**October 25:** As the reluctant father of Impressionism, and the painter of *Dejeuner sur L'Herbe*, Manet can probably be accused of inventing modern art. Using the life of Manet as his narrative arc, Waldemar Januszczak will tell the story of a complex and difficult man who started a revolution that continues to rumble on today. 1 hr. 30 mins.

**November 8:** This film captures the inspiration for and creation of Alexander Calder's delightful creations. 57 min.
