A painter of seaside life, Elizabeth Mumford paints in a whimsical style replete with a nautical theme reminiscent of the simple pleasures and traditions of our American heritage. Her style is influenced by American Folk Art as well as Flemish painters of the 16th Century, primarily Breughel. Liz's "signature" is a black painted border with bronze stenciled corners and red lettered text of quotations, bible verses and conventional New England wisdom.

Liz's art is appreciated by collectors across the U.S. including exhibitions at Mystic Seaport Maritime Gallery, the Cotuit Center for the Art and the Cahoon Museum in Cotuit.
