1: it's your choice whether or not to answer the questions on page two, but that information would be helpful to the instructor and we hope you will complete those questions. personal information you choose to give will only be disclosed to the FAC Director and the instructor

2: please work directly with the FAC Director and her staff to pay the fee for this workshop. students should bring in their own brushes and palette knives, their favorite paints (acrylic is recommended; oil paint isn't allowed) and mediums, and accessory materials such as cleaning cloths, scrapers, containers in which to mix or put out paints, and the like. the entry fee includes two large canvases (generally 24 x 30) per student and items such as small matboards, insect repellent, sketchbooks, and certain limited drawing materials, all at no cost

3: FAC and the workshop do not supply any food or transportation. please bring a bag lunch to eat during the lunch break, and please notify david ament whenever you're going to leave the classroom you might want to bring coveralls or other protective garments to protect clothing and person against paint, sharp plants, poison ivy, etc. (mosquito and tick repellent will be supplied). we hope that you take some reasonable precautions and then participate fully in all of the activities of the workshop.

4: students are not asked to speak publicly. students who choose to speak should not express any judgment, good or bad, about the work, statements, or ideas of others. any student who intentionally harms another person through the

use of hurtful or inappropriate words will be required to immediately withdraw from the workshop without a refund of any part of the entry fee.
